Winchester's Mad River Recreation Area Trail Improvement Project

One of the cornerstones of Fit Together's Mission is to create accessible, low cost exercise opportunities for all community members. We were looking for areas to expand or improve walking

and biking options and discovered Winchester's Mad River Recreation Area. We walked the property with members of Winsted Trails and agreed with the appropriate trail improvements the area could benefit the community greatly by becoming a beautiful destination for walking, hiking, and biking.

Steps Made to Date:

- Created a Concept Map of area.
- Gained community wide support for project including Town of Winchester, Mayor of Winsted, Winchester Land Trust, Winsted Trails, Charlotte Hungerford Hospital, NW Hills Counsel of Government, Highland Lake Association, Friends of Main Street and the Economic Development Commission.
- Obtained DEEP approval for phase one planning and design.
- Hosted and guided a 3 mile Mad River Friends and Partner hike.
- Consulted with trail design firms with the goal to complete a trail design plan by spring of 2022.

Sue Grossman Still Water River Greenway Linear Fitness Trail Ribbon Cutting August 2020



Fit Together funded and teamed up with Torrington Parks and Recreation to install six pieces of fitness equipment along the trail providing all our community members from kids, families to older adults easy, inexpensive opportunities to get more movement into their lives. Fit Together placed QR codes on each equipment sign linking directly to a how to video performed by Fit Together Staff.



Executive Summary

Well, what a couple of years it has been! When Fit Together first formed ten years ago no one would have imaged the transformation and adaptations we have been through. Initially, funded with a Sam's Club grant through the YMCA of the USA, as a group of volunteer community based organizations, we began empowering our community to make the healthy choice the easy choice; we supported school gardens, assisted in school wellness policies and promoted ways to get physical activity every day. By 2014 we hired our first Fit Together Coordinator and adapted Let's Go Maine 5210 model developing partners with early childcare centers.

In 2018 with the support of a five year, \$500K grant received from Hartford HealthCare as a result of their affiliation with Torrington's Charlotte Hungerford Hospital, Fit Together has been able to advance our mission to build the healthiest kids, families and communities through sustainable strategies that foster healthy eating and active living.

We were on our way- expanding our partner reach by adding more early childcare centers, signing on schools partners, pediatricians and began to award GOLD level partner status and our first round of mini grants. Late in 2019 it looked like our count of Gold Partners would blossom ... and then the pandemic.

Due to COVID-19, Fit Together like so many others has had to shift the way we do our work in order to continue to support the children, families and adults served by our initiative. It has been challenging but at the same time an opportunity for creativity. This annual progress report provides a picture of the work that was accomplished throughout 2020-2021.

I want to thank our many partners, our Steering Committee and coordinators who are working in our community. You help us implement healthy eating and active living strategies, and continue to adapt during this difficult time. We are stronger together!

As I look back on these past ten years—I see the momentum we have sustained and the changes Fit Together has helped support, and I am confident the next ten year years we will continue to build a healthier community. These gold level sites were identified because they instill a positive relationship with food and enthusiasm for healthy choices by promoting evidence based strategies such as limiting or eliminating sugary drinks, promoting water as the drink of choice, prohibiting the use of food as a reward, limiting unhealthy choices during snacks and celebrations, and providing opportunities for physical activity outside of recess on a daily basis. They also offer practice specific, obesity prevention program components that include providing consistent 5–2–1–0 messaging in offices.
